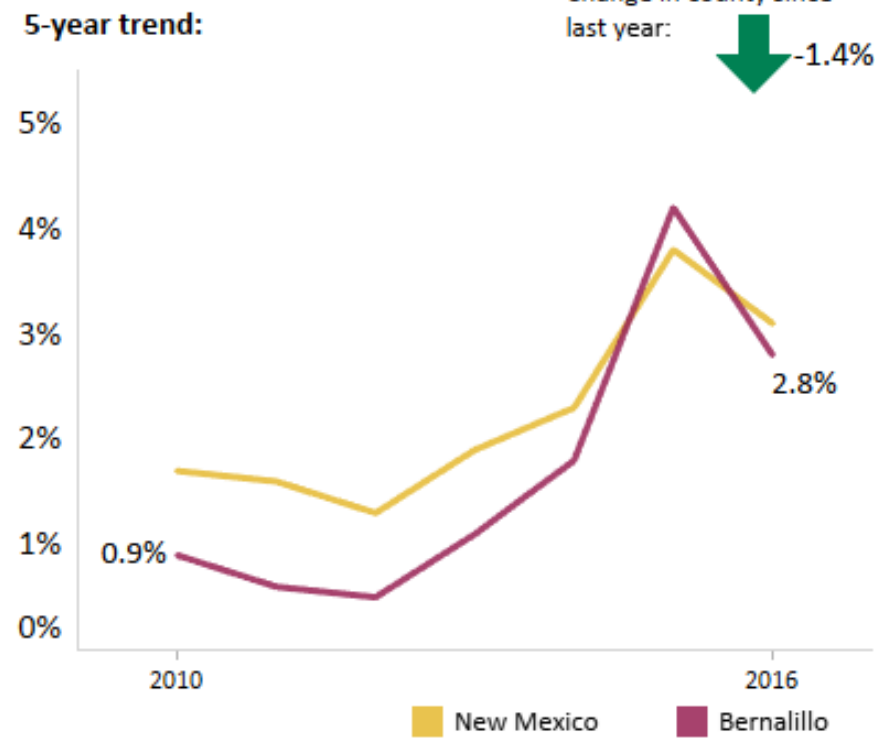
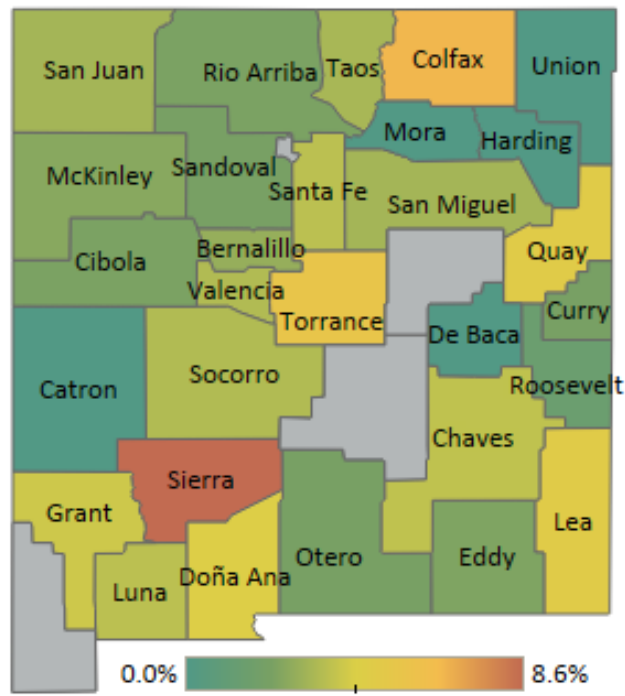


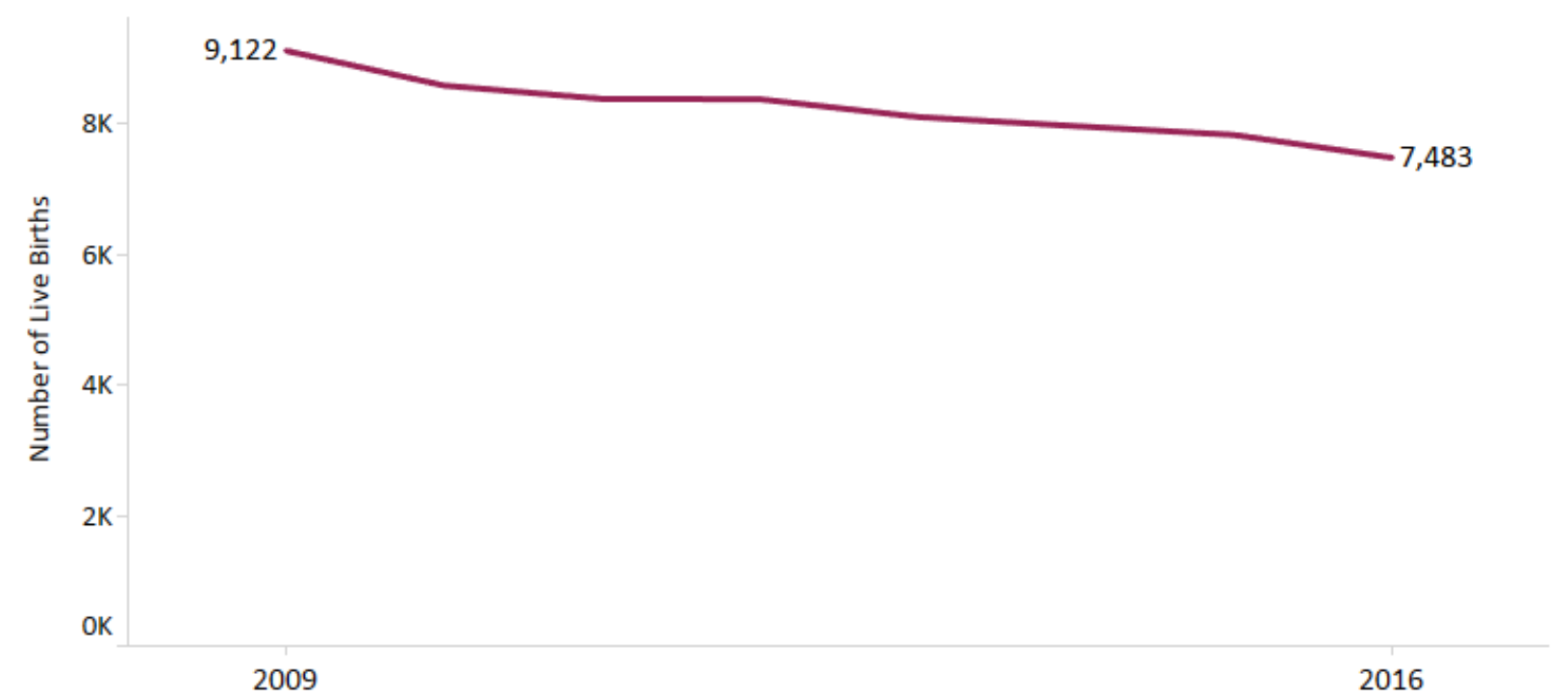

Percent of mothers who did not receive prenatal care, 2016



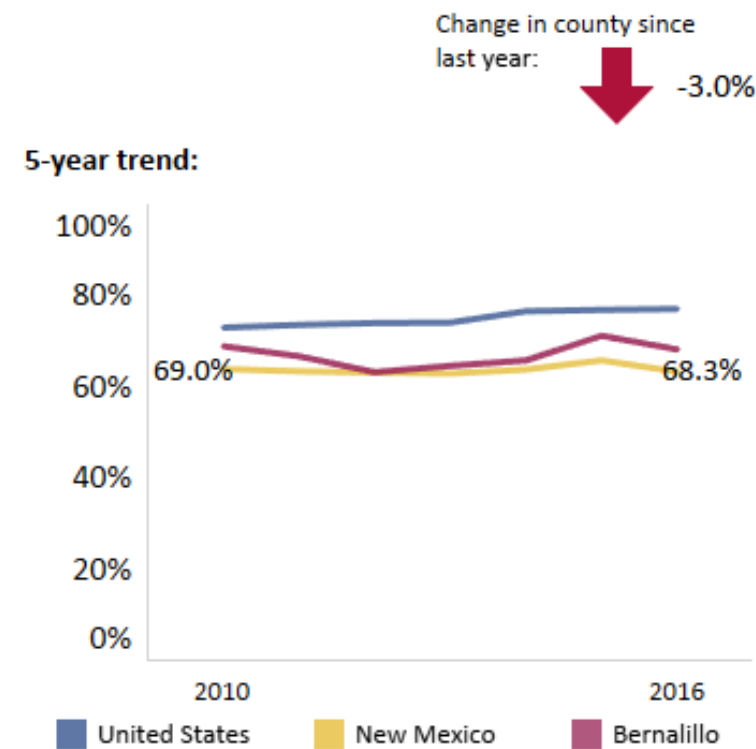
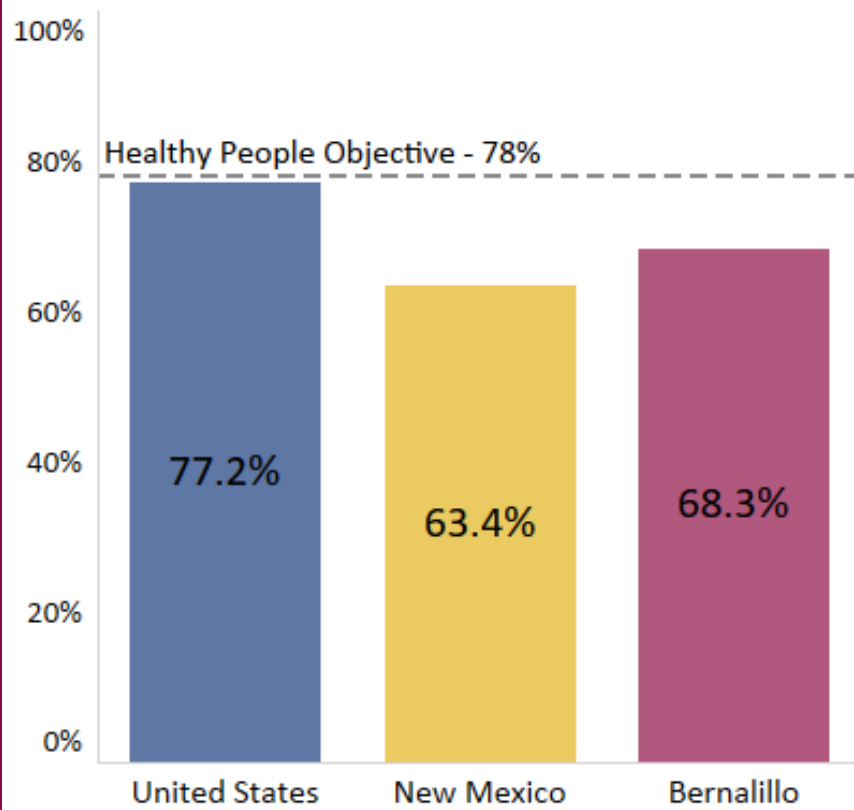

Birth Rate in Bernalillo County, 2009-2016

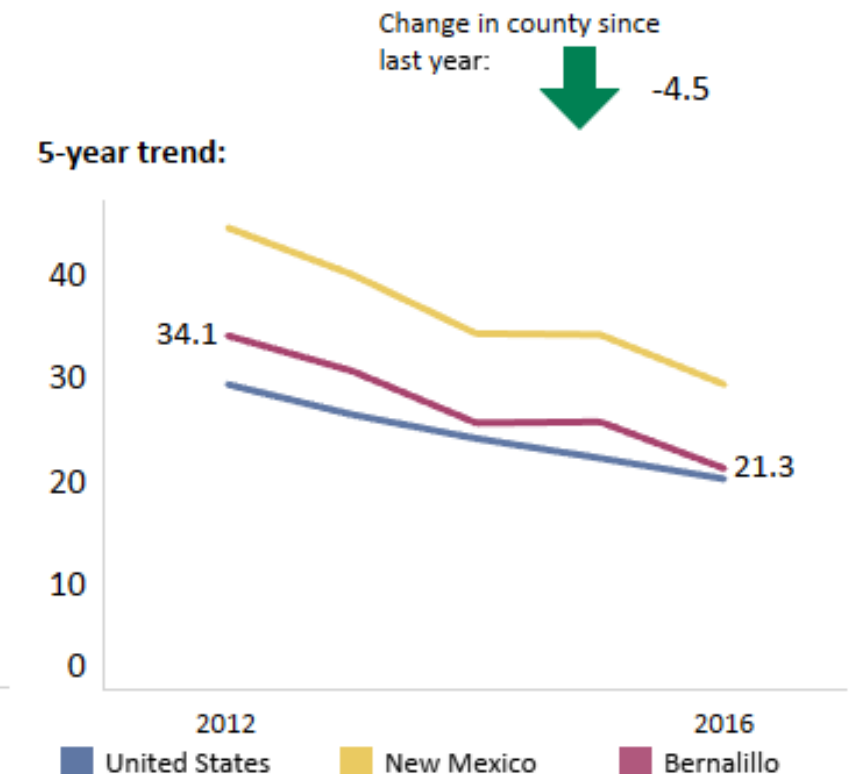
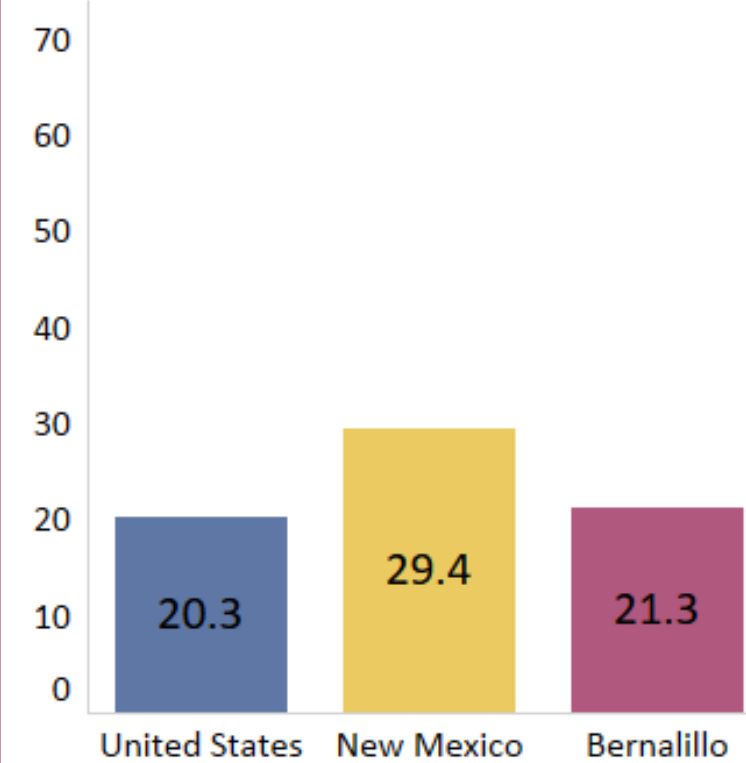


34.8% of mothers 15 to 50 who gave birth in the past 12 months live below 100% of the poverty line in Bernalillo

Number of births per 1,000 female teens ages 15-19, 2016

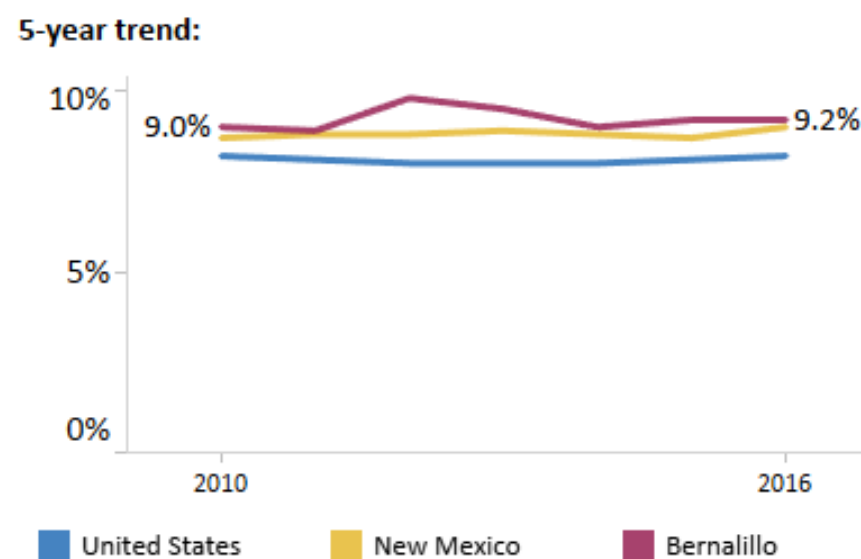
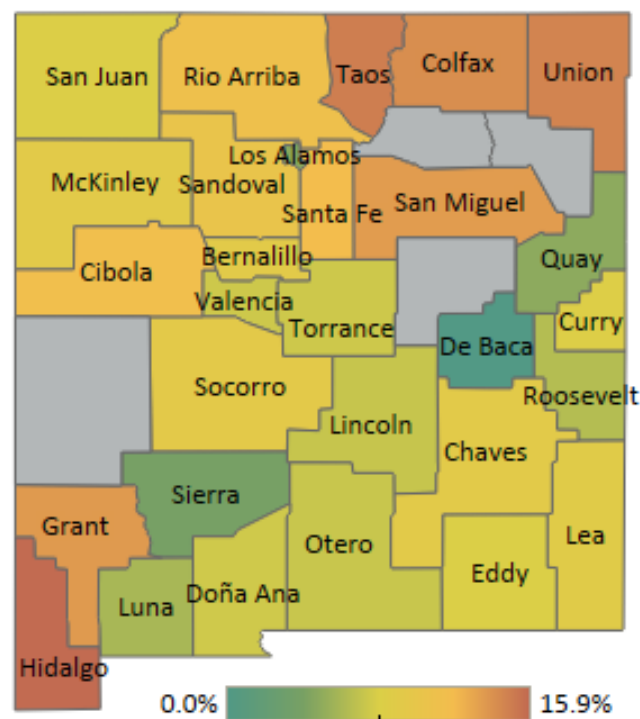

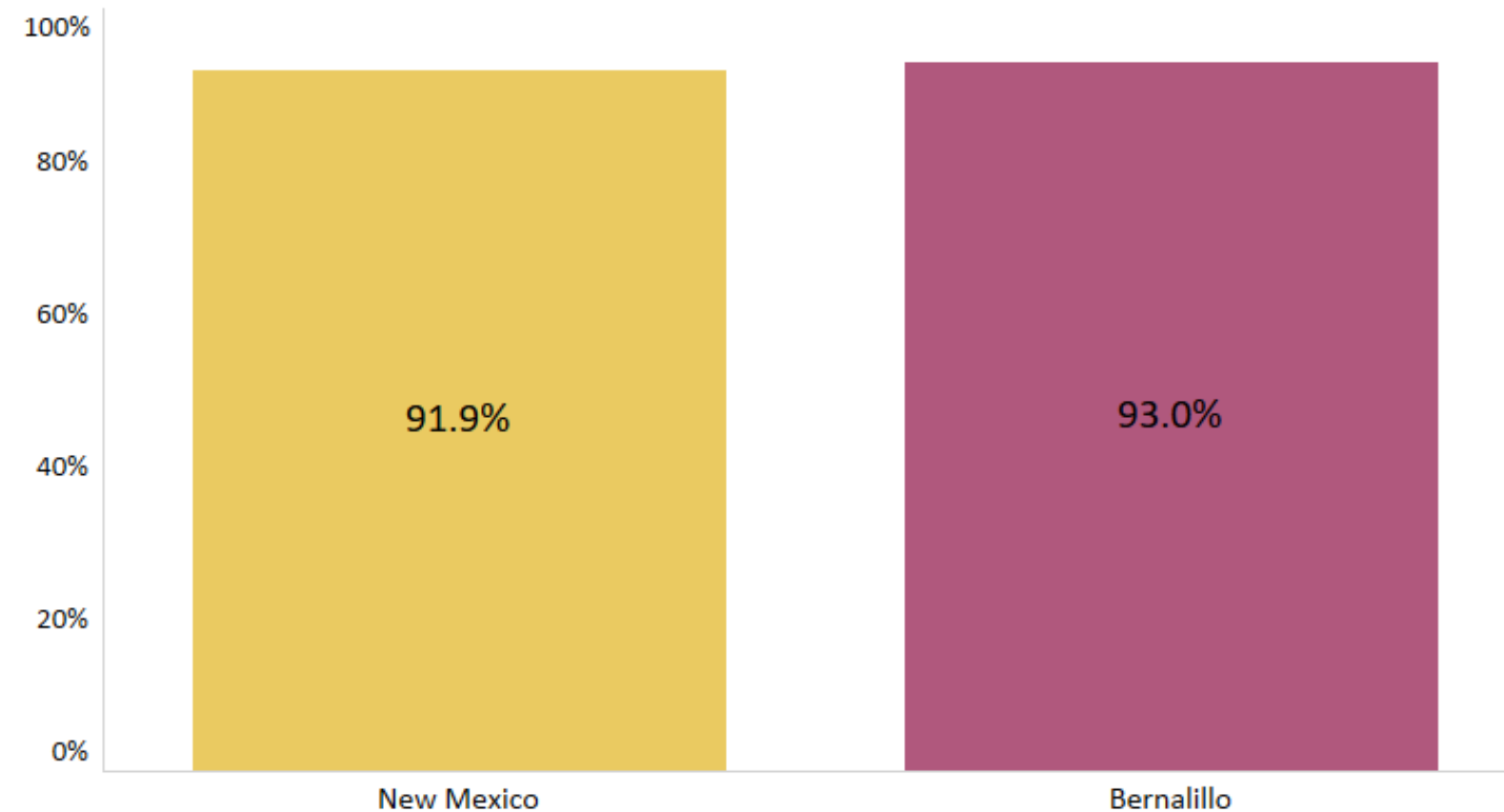

Percent of babies with low or very low birthweight, 2016

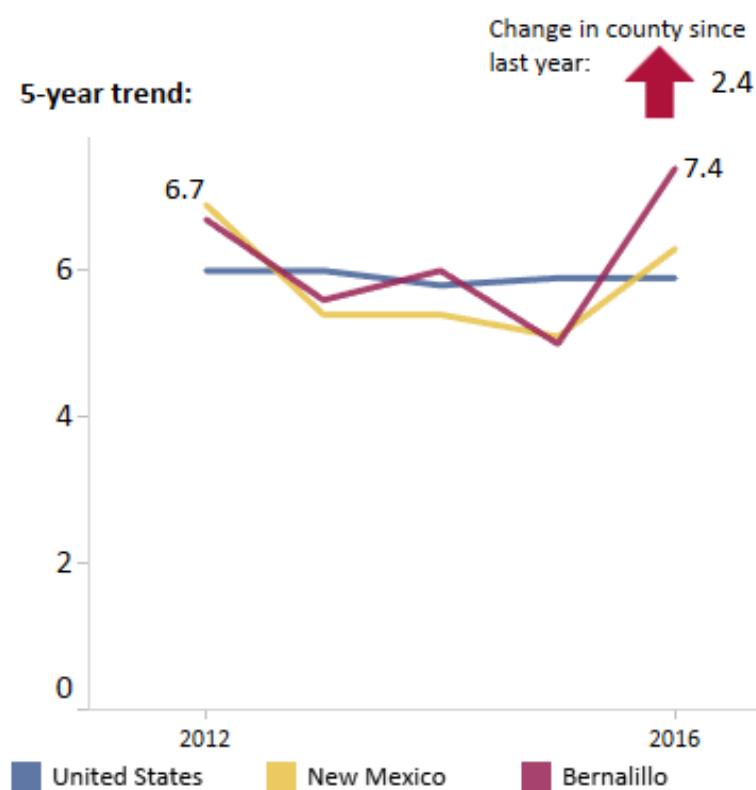
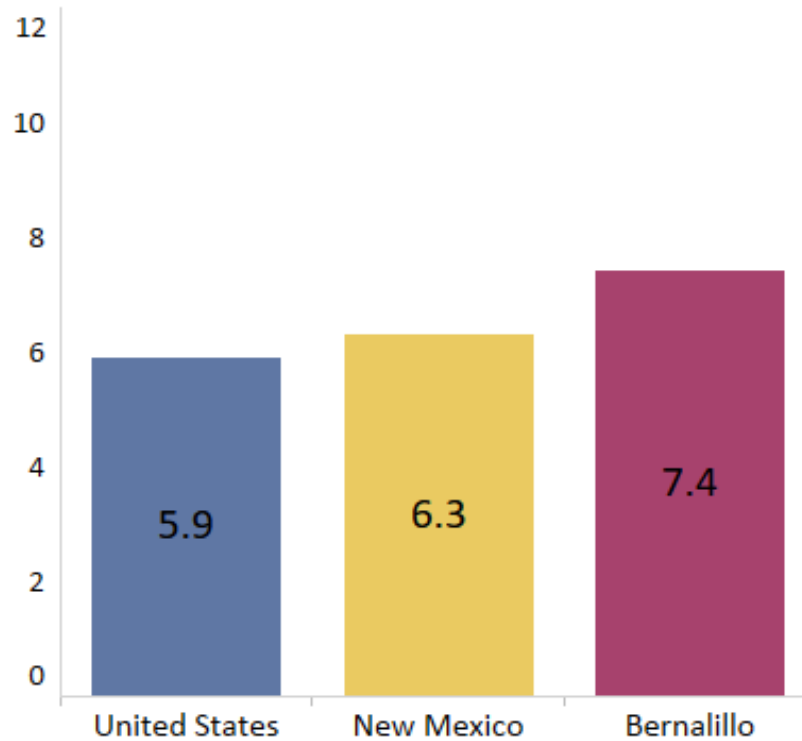

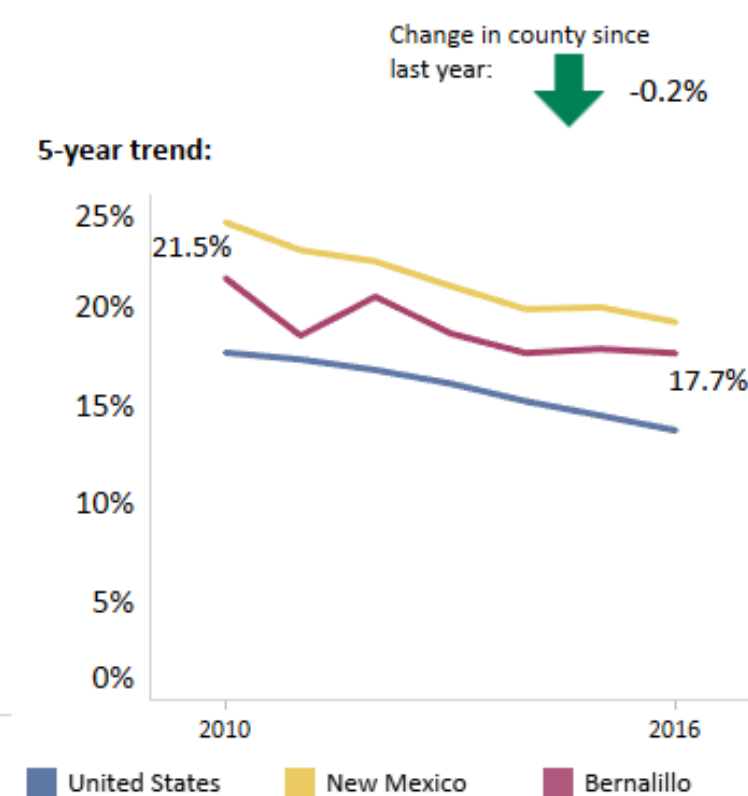
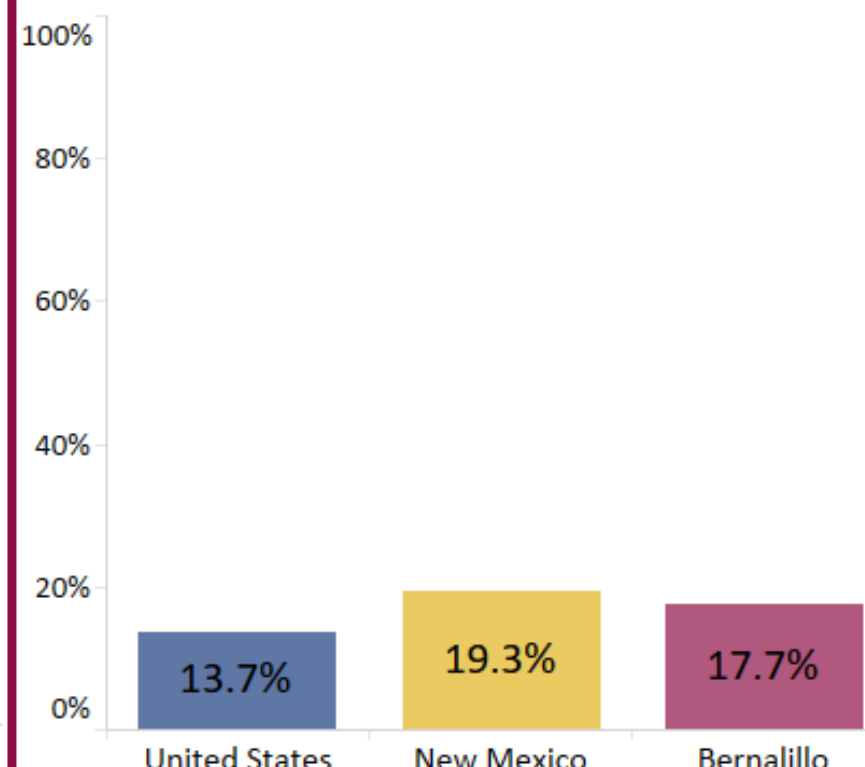
Percent of children 24-35 months who have been immunized by their second birthday, 2016

Percent of mothers ages 15 to 50 who have given birth in the past 12 months with less than a high school diploma, 2016

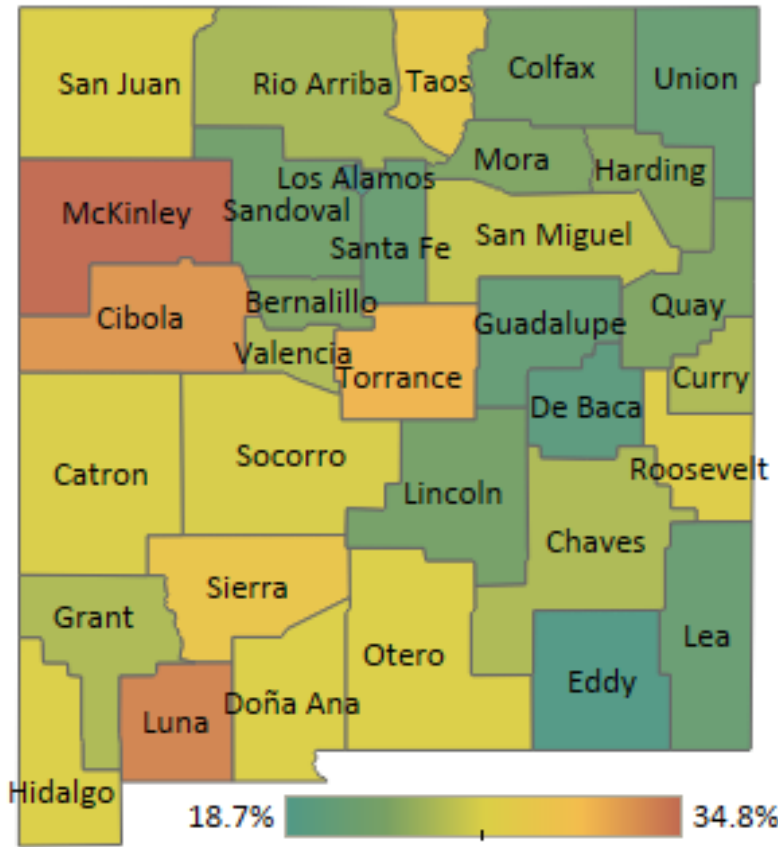

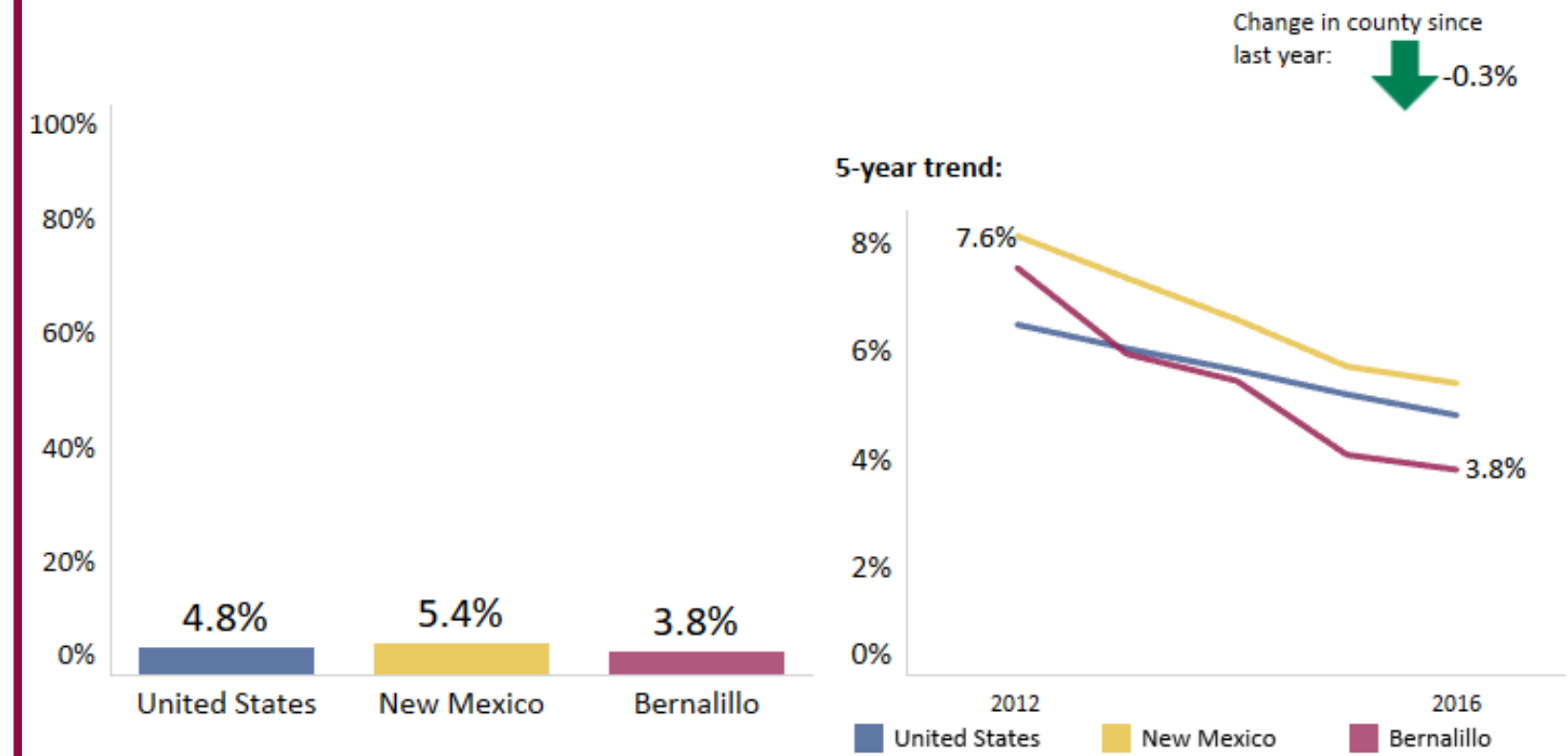

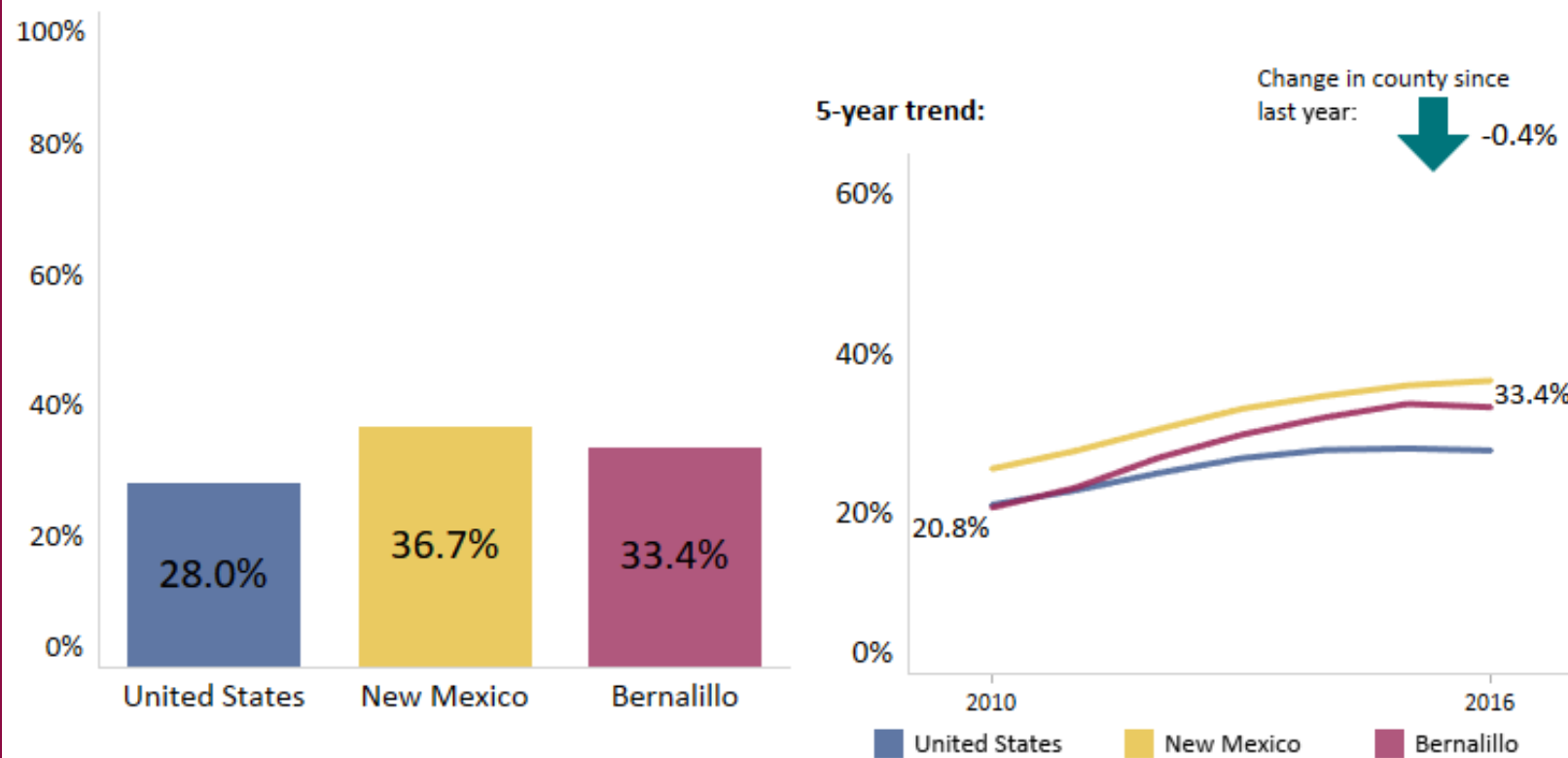
Percent of children under 18 in food insecure homes, 2015



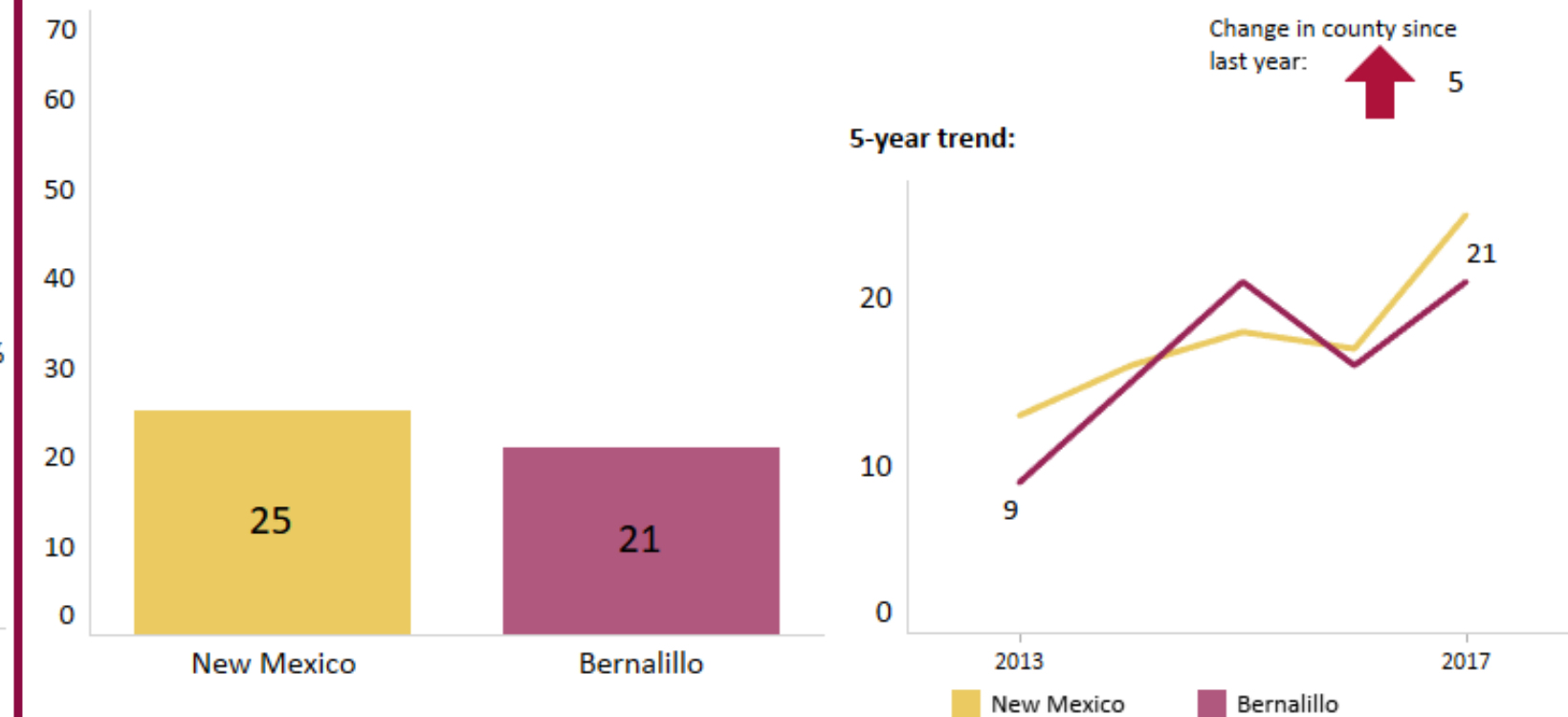
Percent of children without health insurance, 2016
