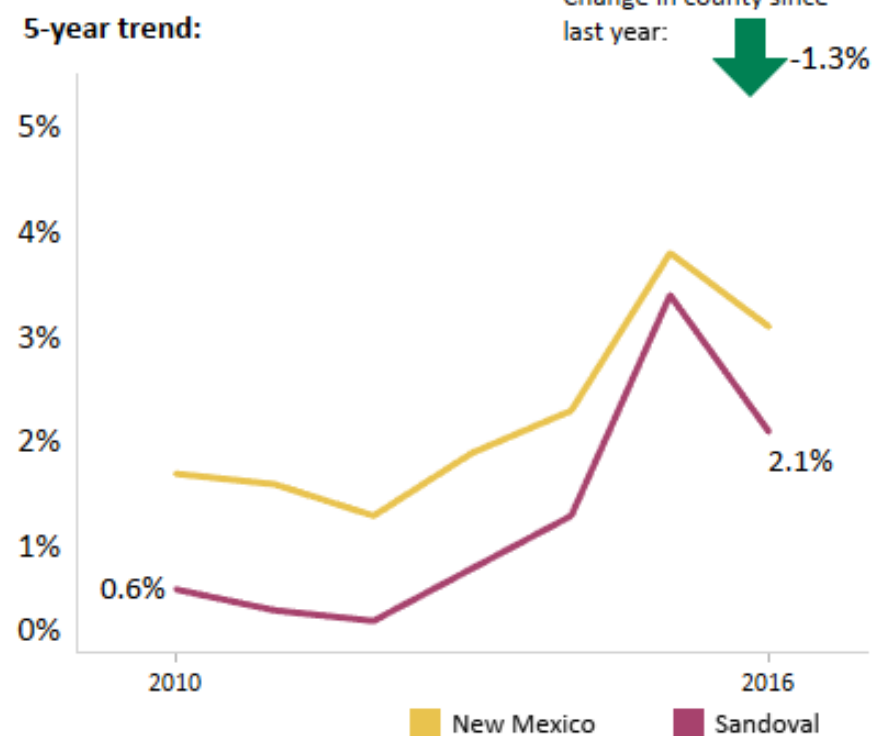
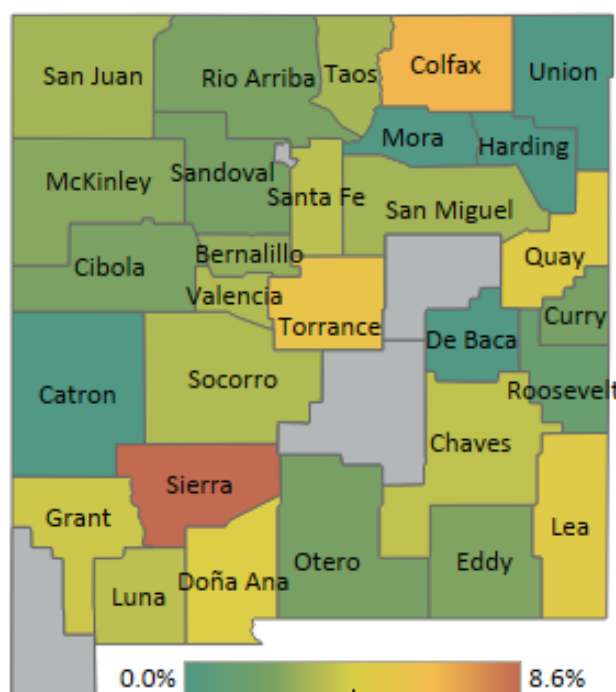


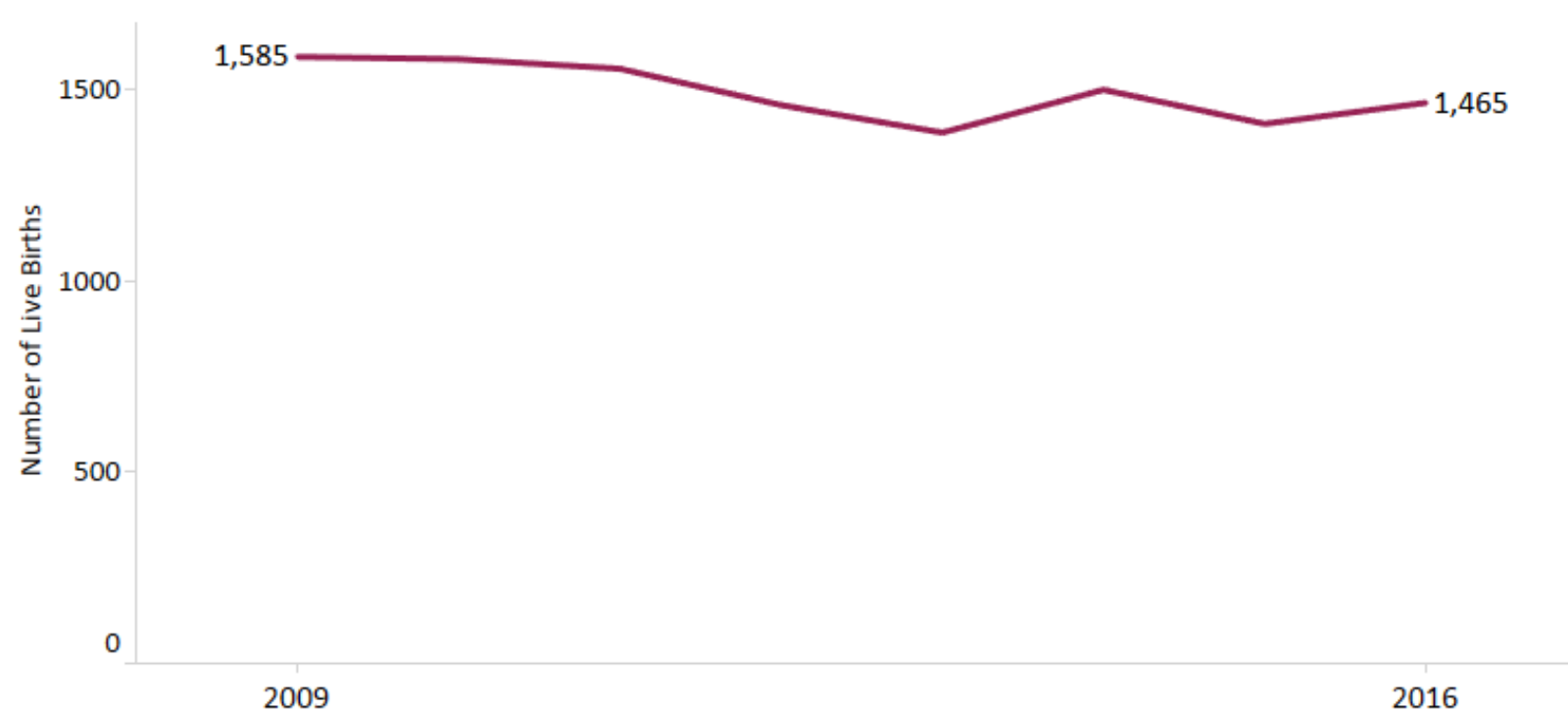

Percent of mothers who did not receive prenatal care, 2016



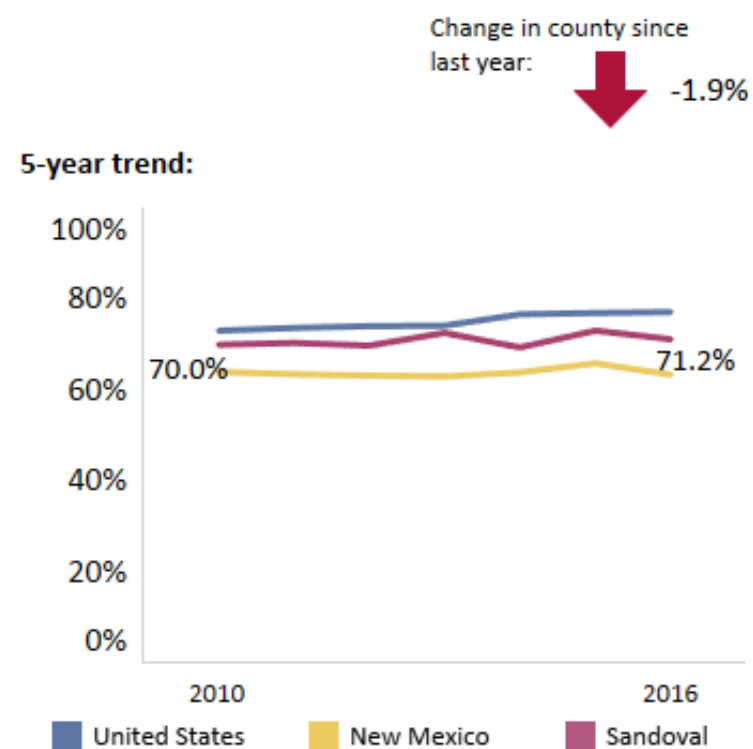
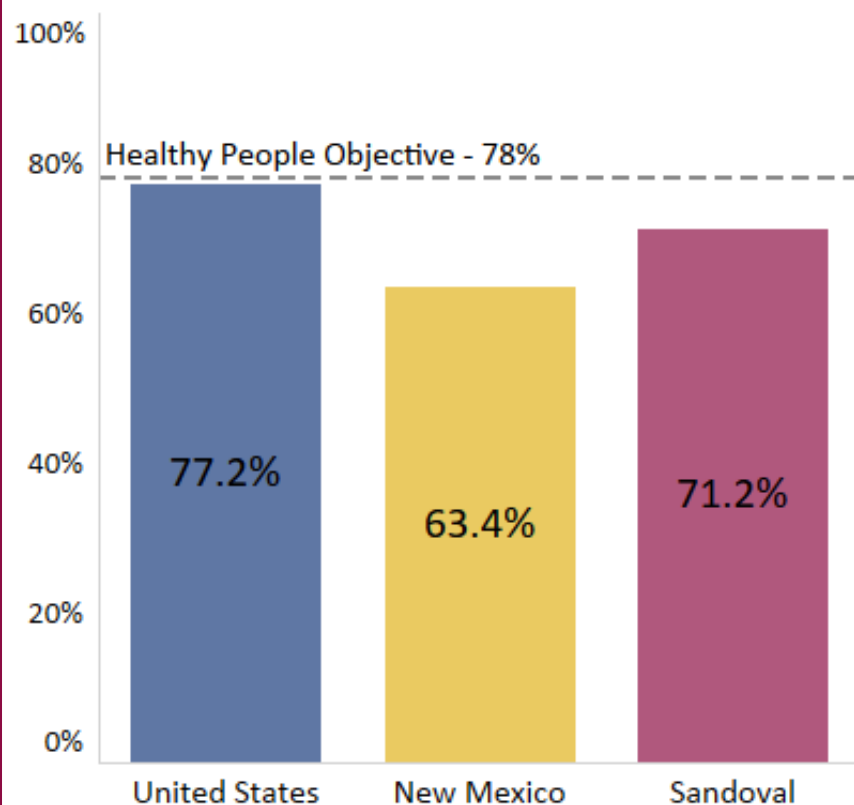

Birth Rate in Sandoval County, 2009-2016

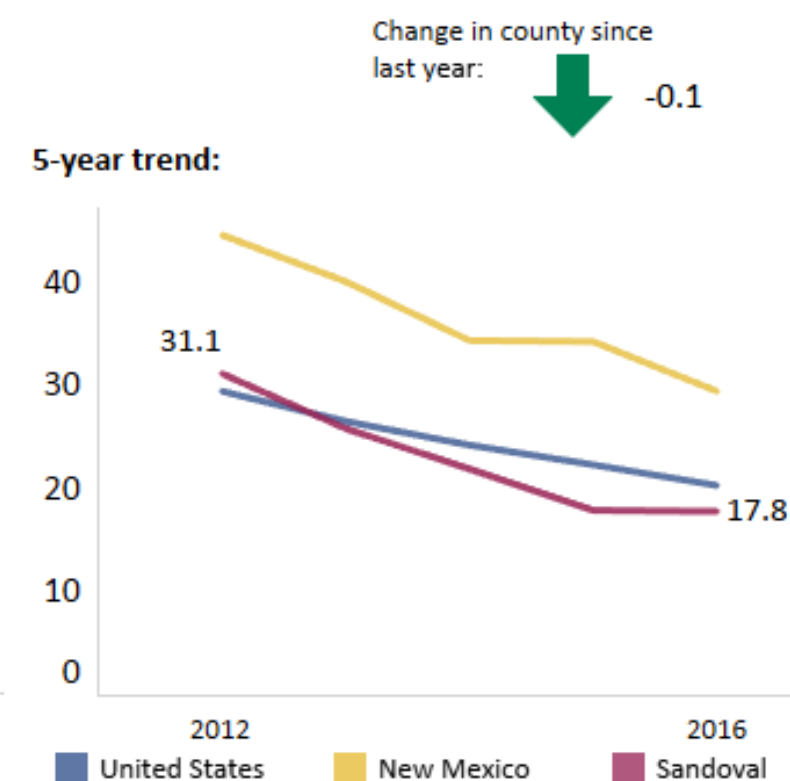
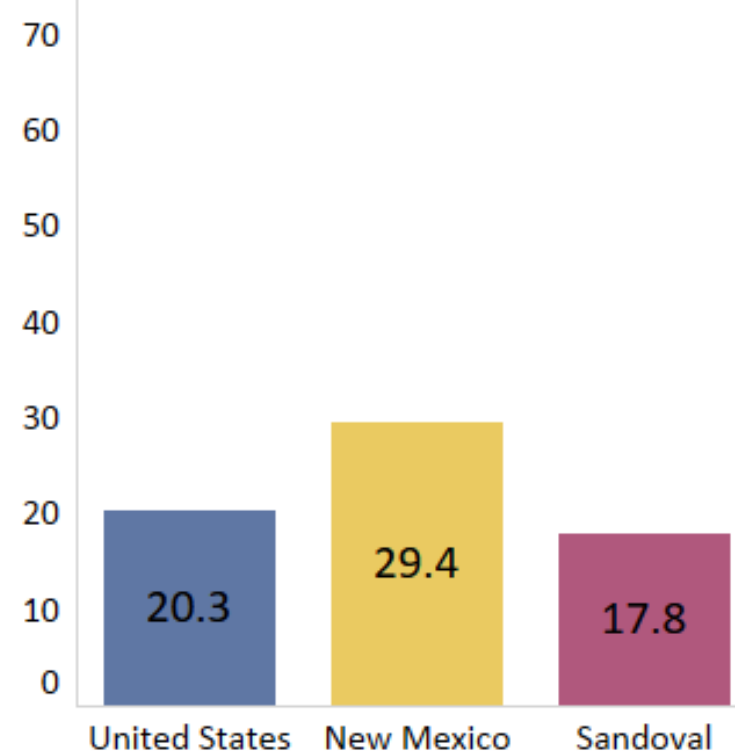


16.7% of mothers 15 to 50 who gave birth in the past 12 months live below 100% of the poverty line in Sandoval

Number of births per 1,000 female teens ages 15-19, 2016

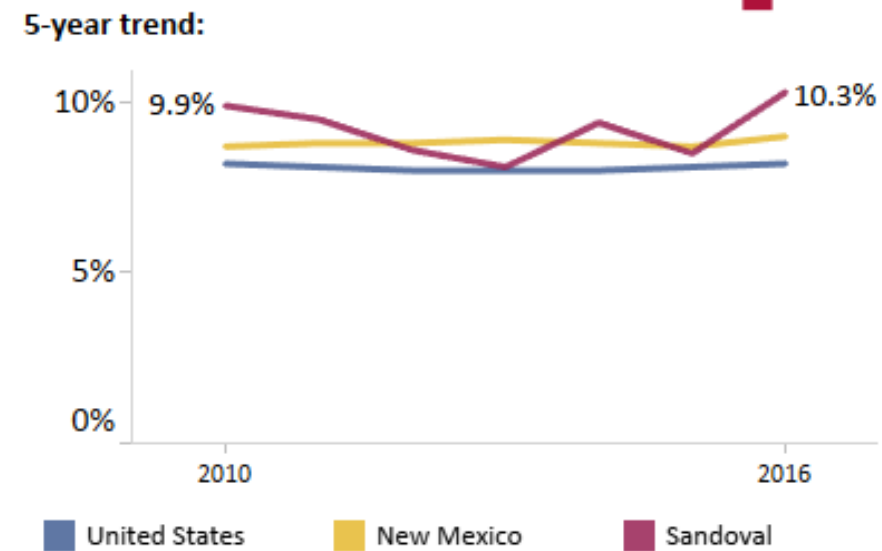
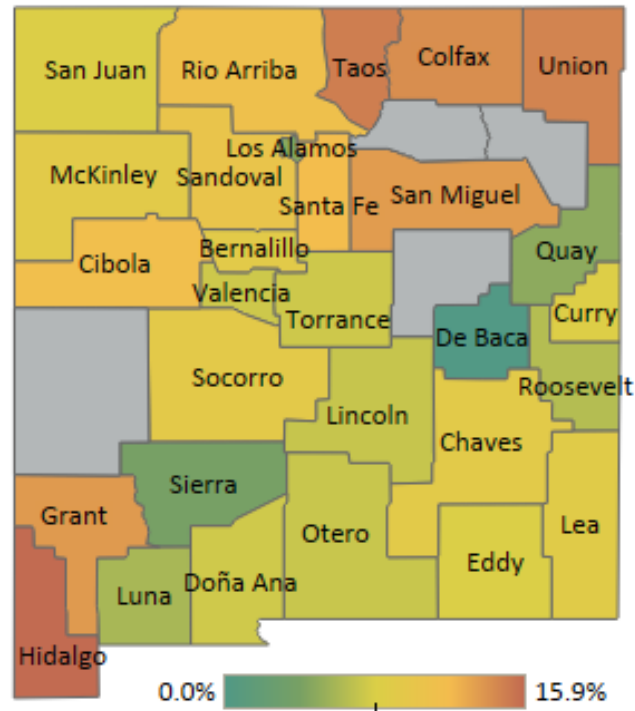

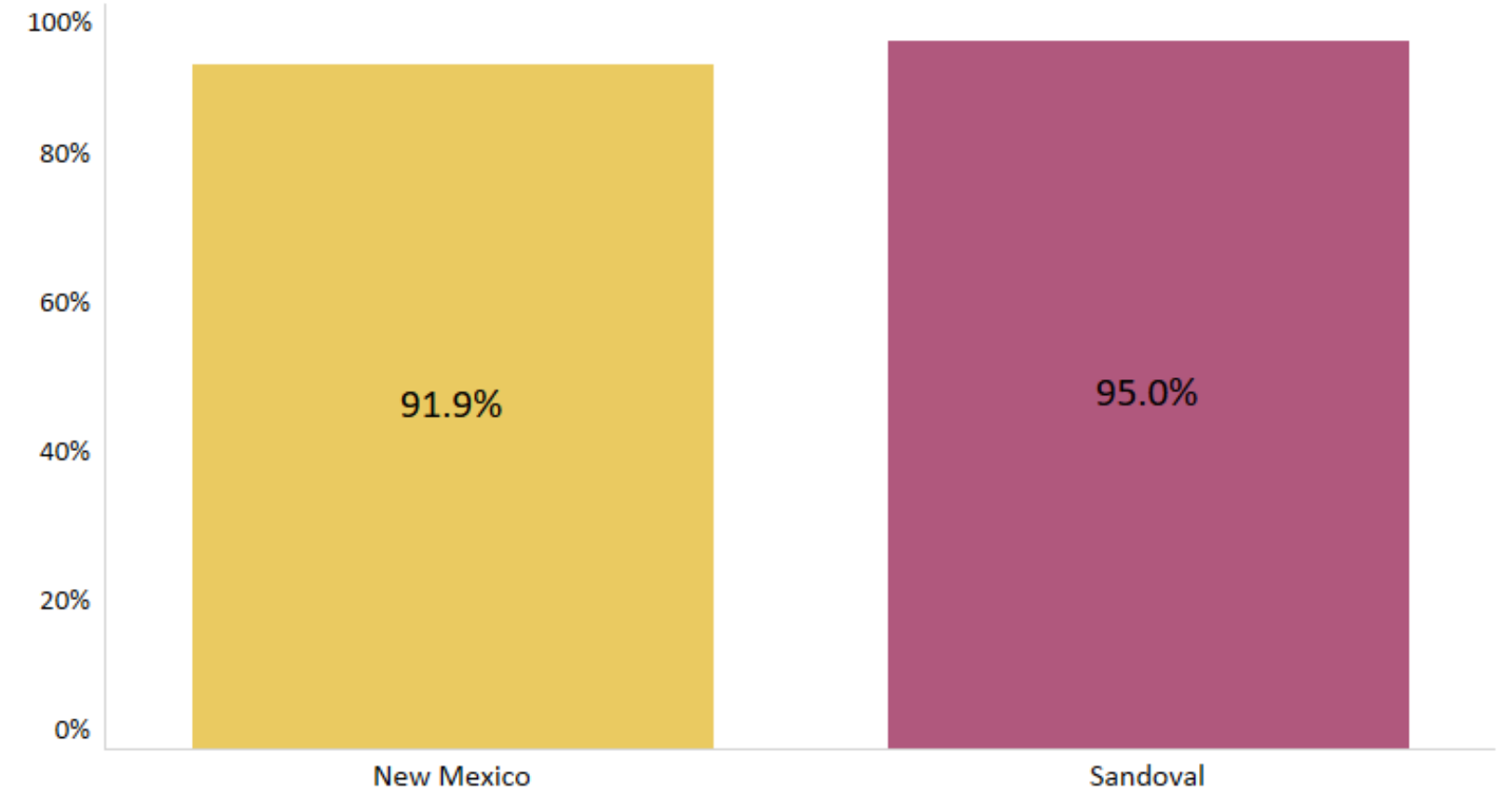

Percent of babies with low or very low birthweight, 2016

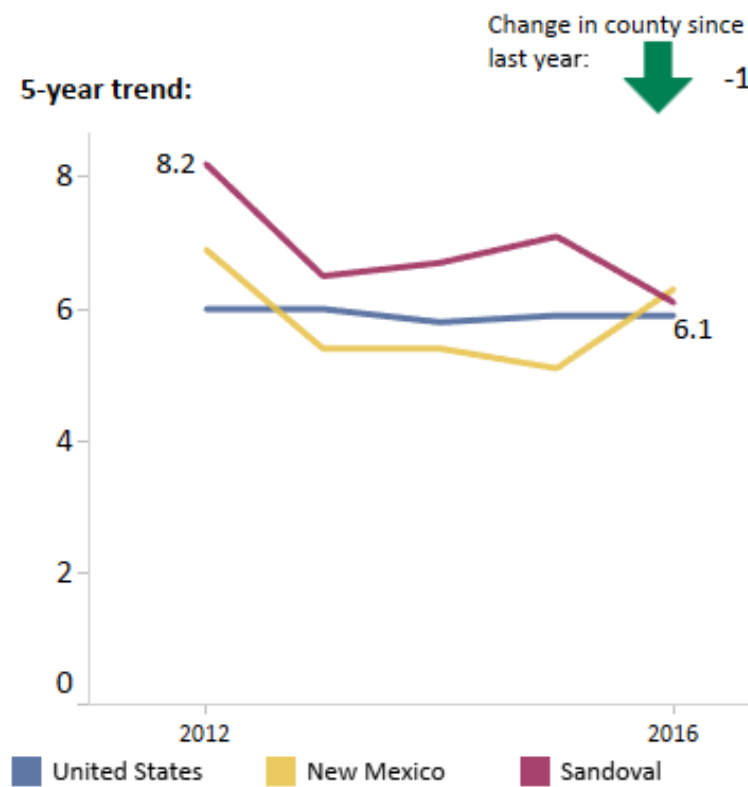
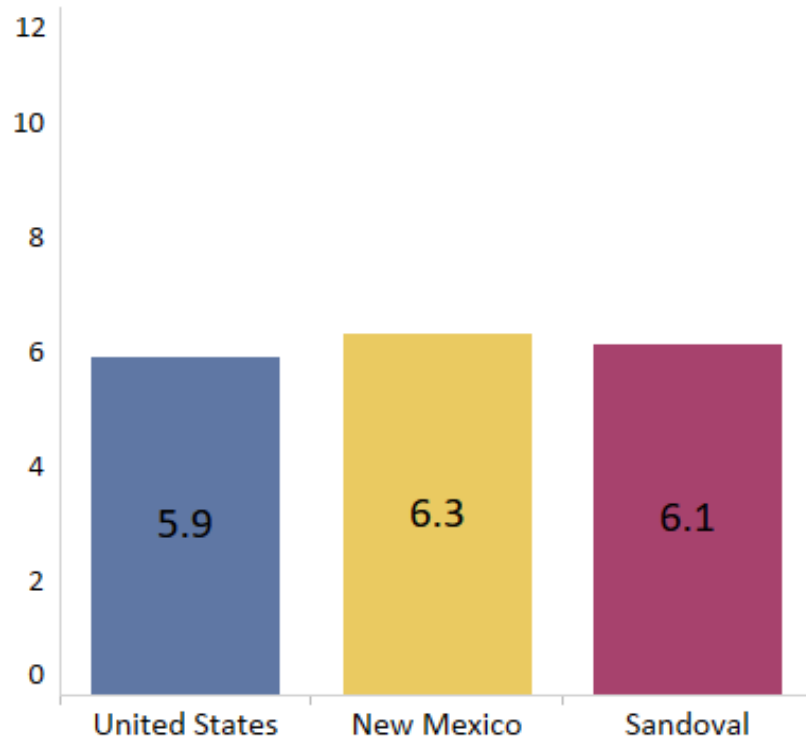

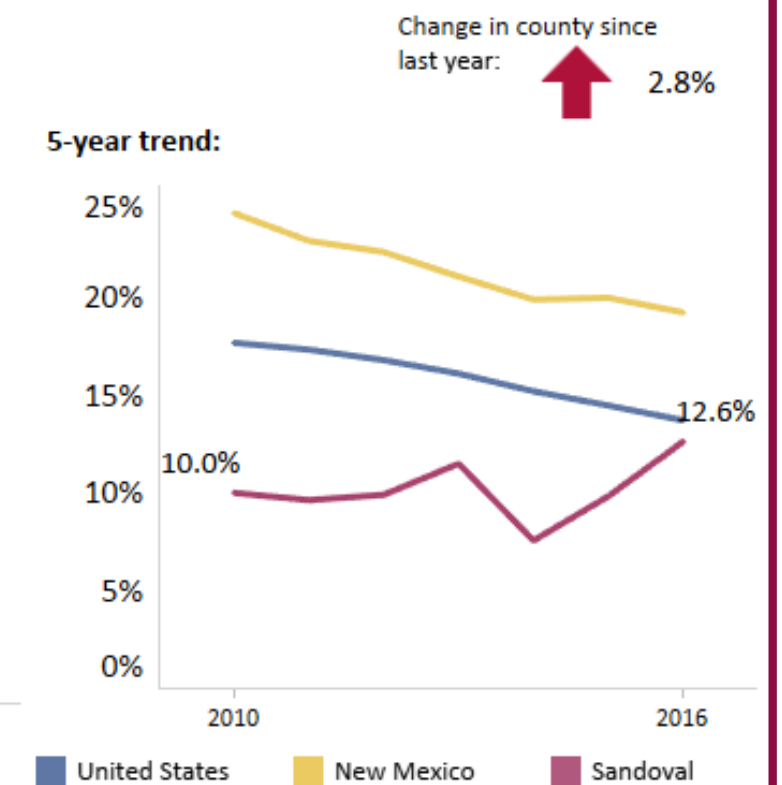
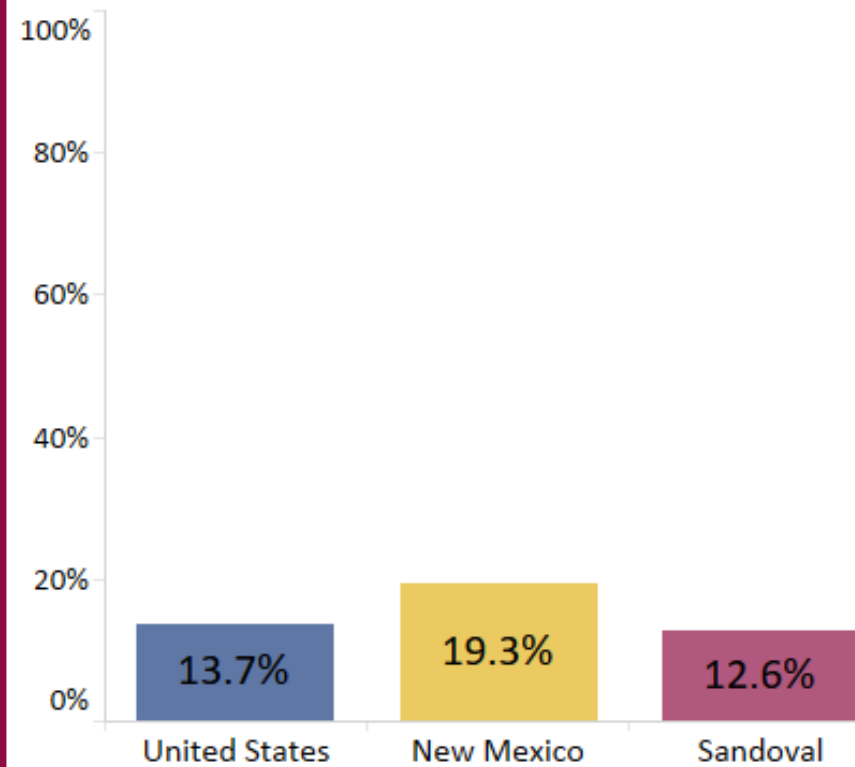
Percent of children 24-35 months who have been immunized by their second birthday, 2016
