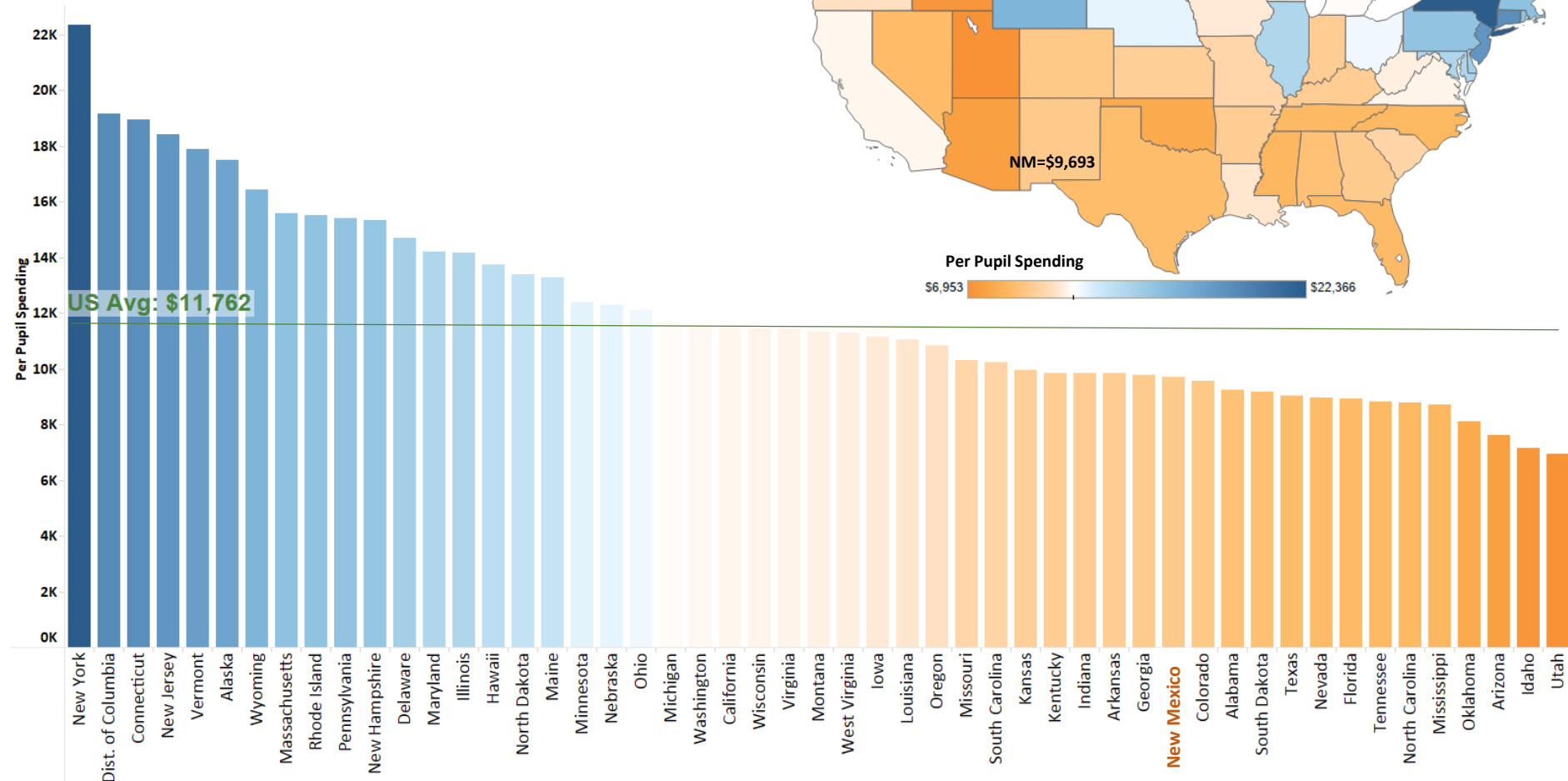
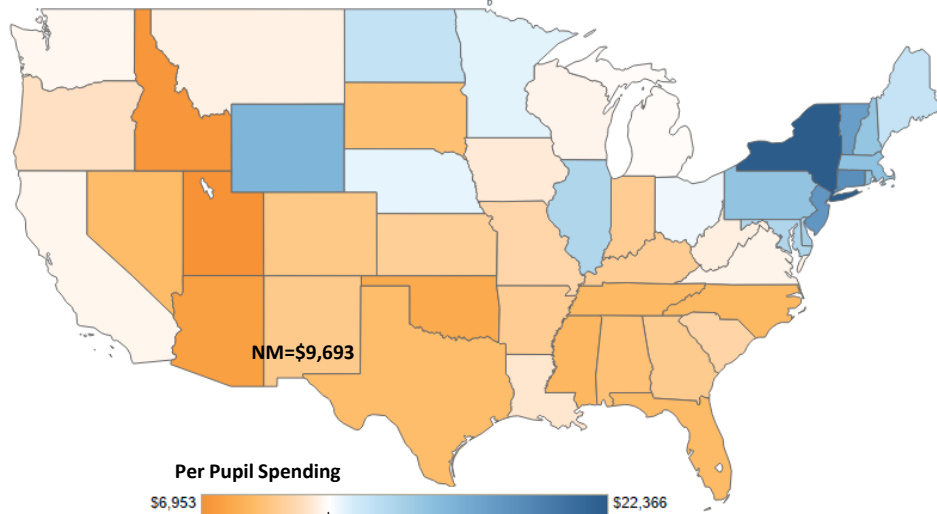


Elementary-Secondary Public Education Per Pupil Spending by State, 2016

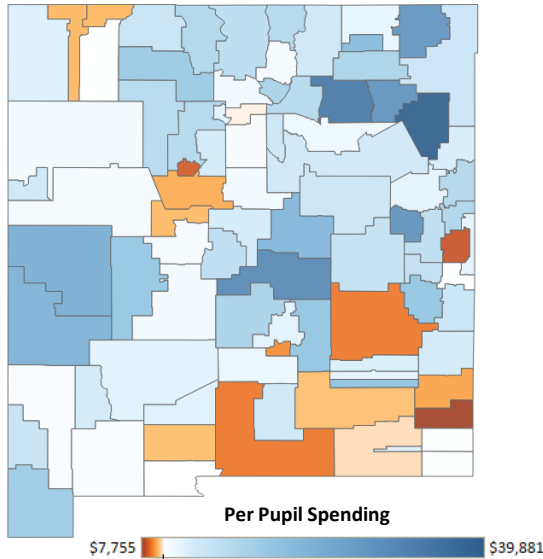
Elementary-secondary education spending per student in the United States = \$11,762.
 States in white are close to the national rate, orange states are lower and blue states are higher.



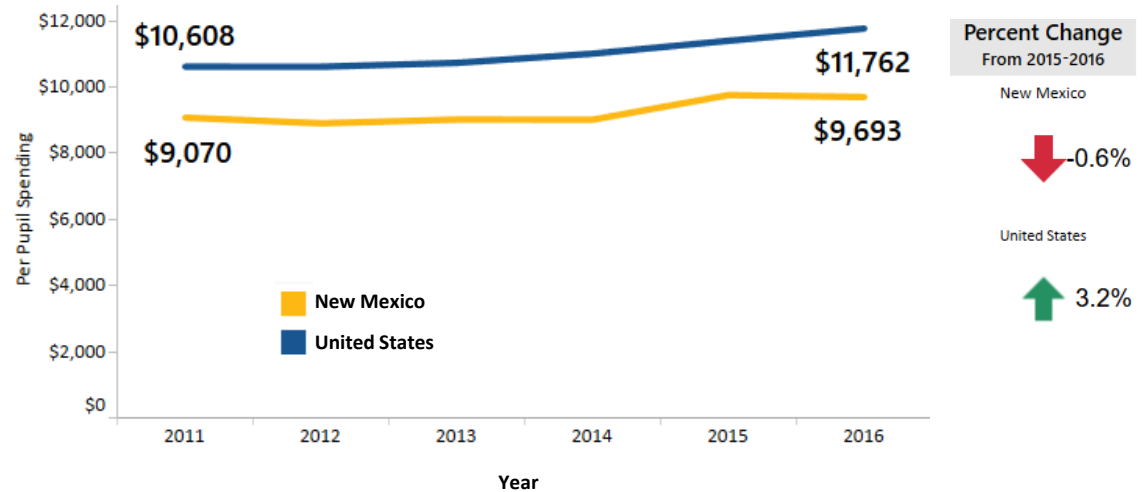
