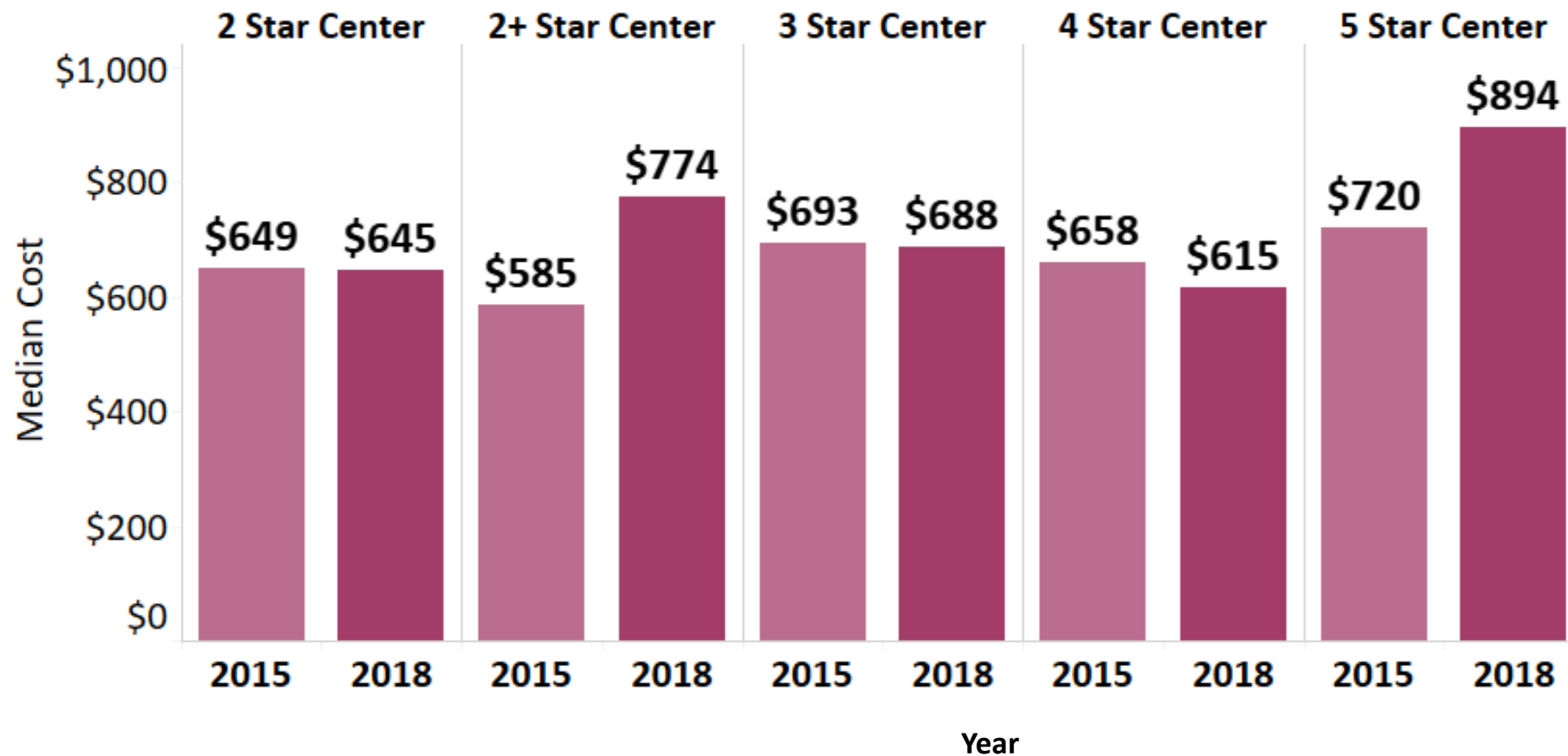
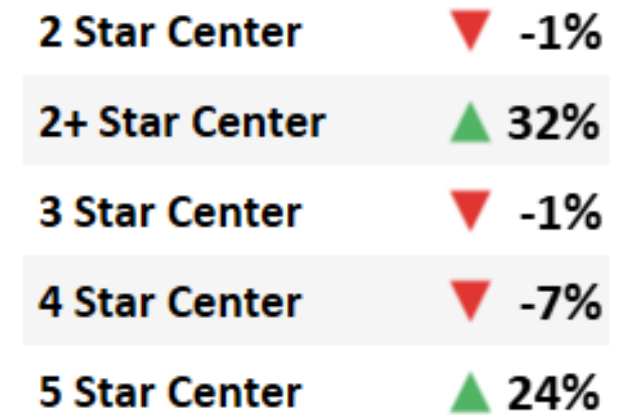

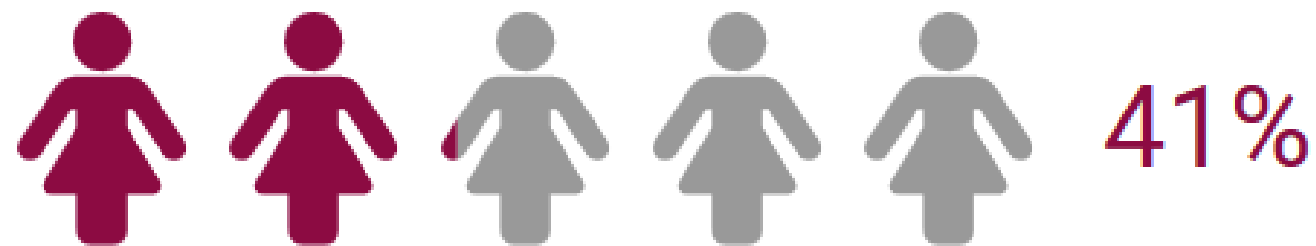
How much does it cost per month to enroll an **infant** in a licensed child care center in Doña Ana County?

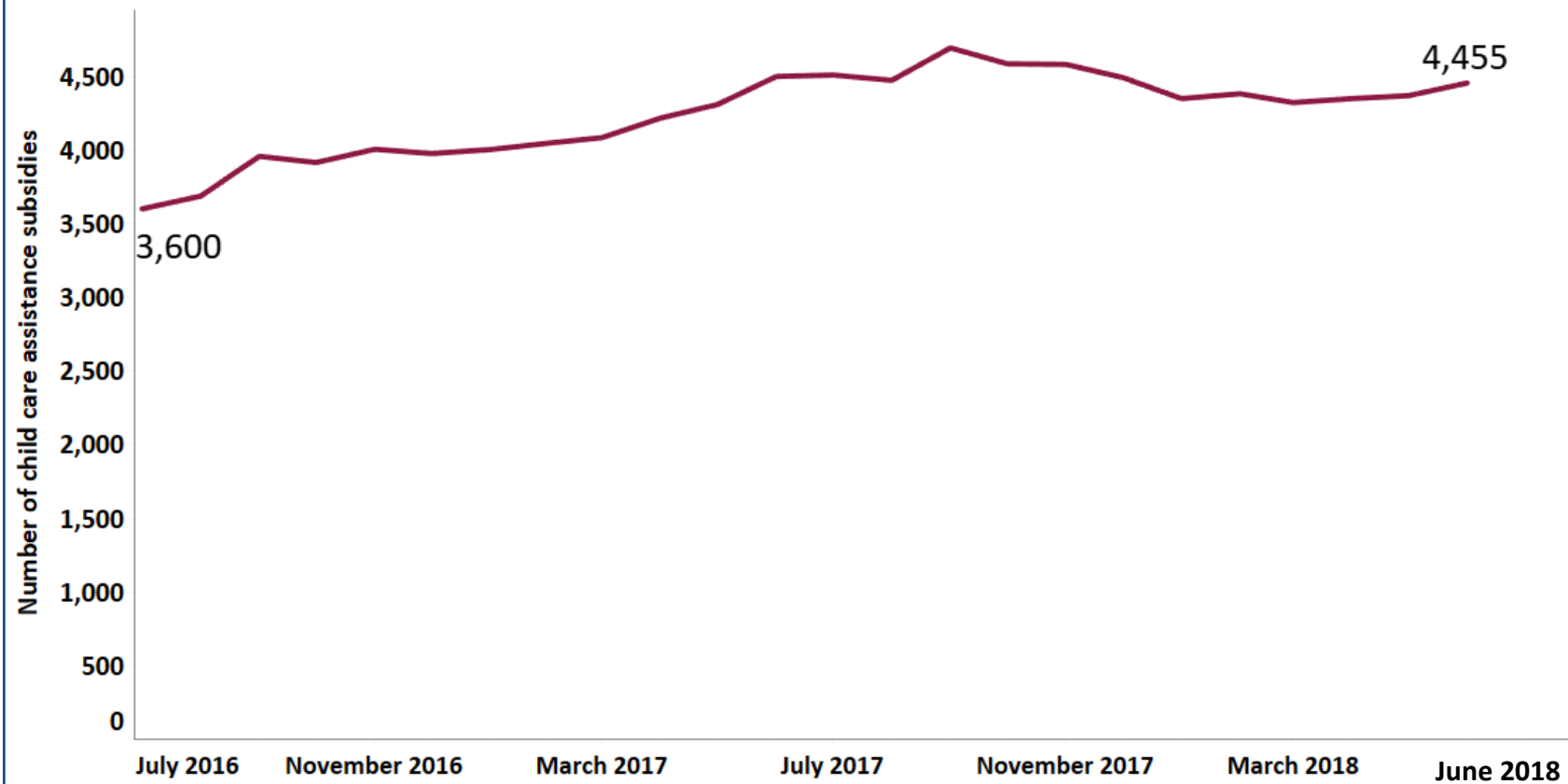

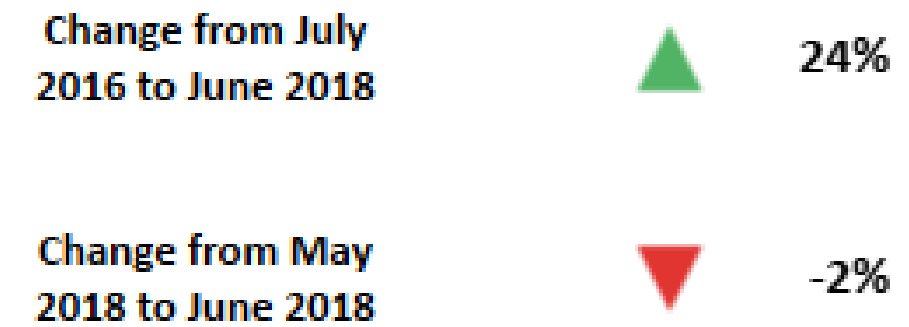

Child Care Assistance Subsidies in Doña Ana County

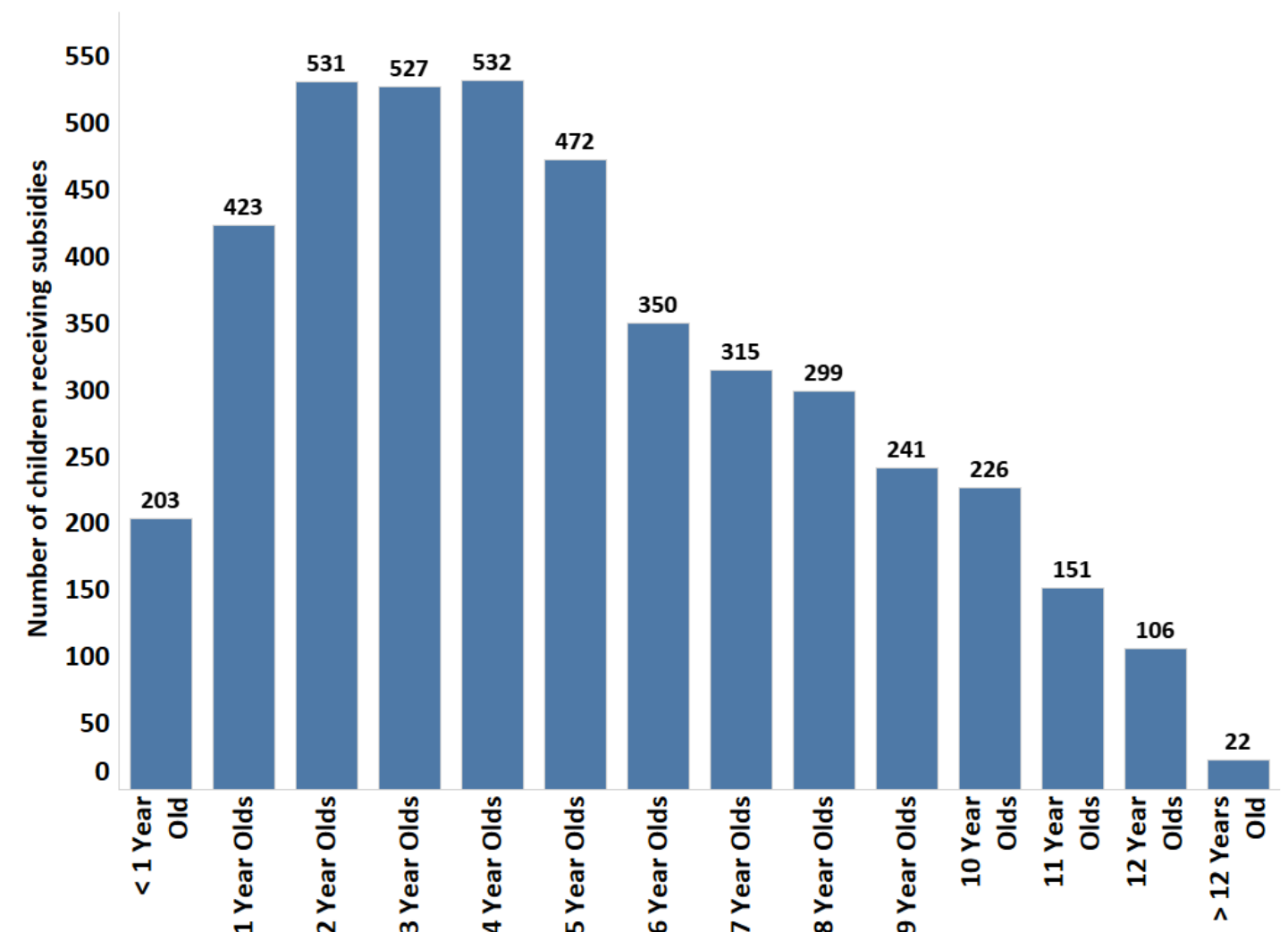
Total children under 13 years old receiving child care assistance subsidies in Doña Ana County, July 2016 - June 2018



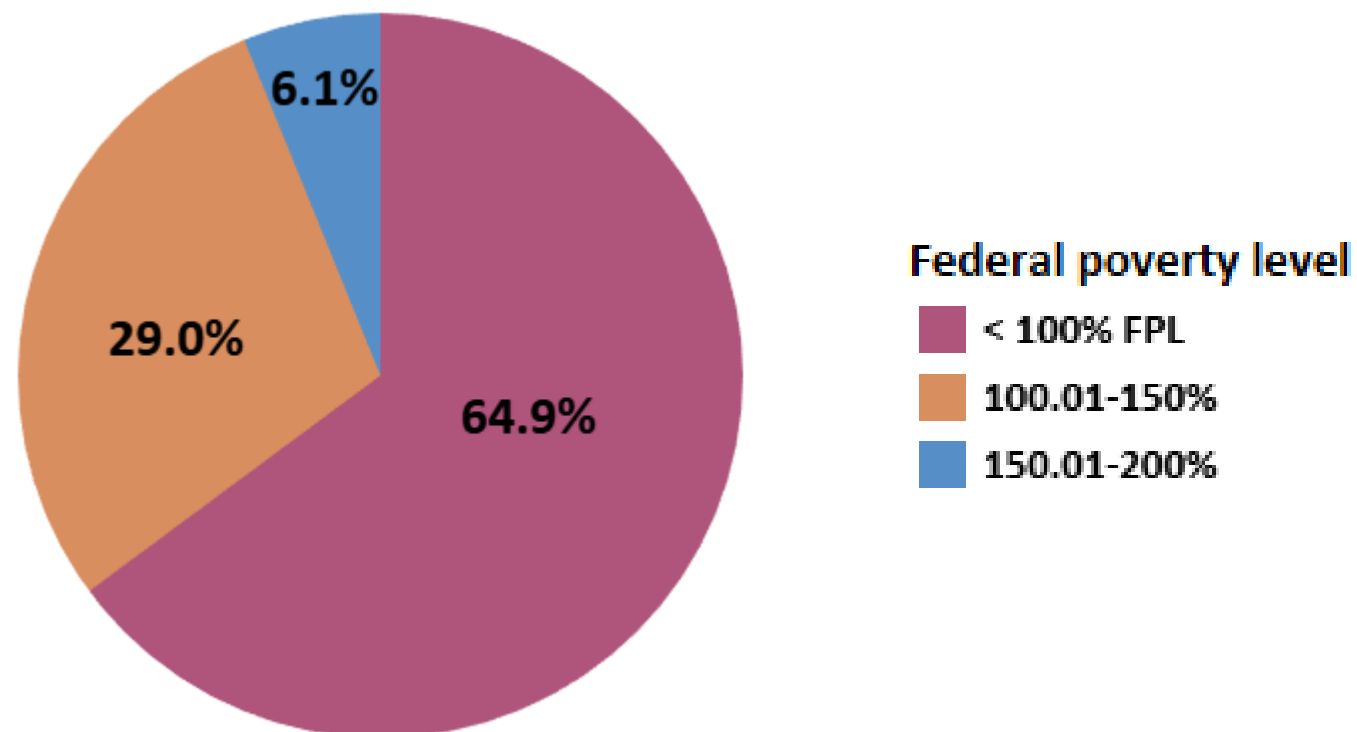
Percent change of children under 13 years old receiving child care assistance subsidies
